



REGISTRATION OF A CHILD BORN WITHIN WEDLOCK OF HIS PARENTS

General requirements:

- 1) Fully filled-in, dated and signed registration form for minor signed by both parents (click on FORMS in *Quick Links*).
- 2) Fully legalized and translated Birth Certificate (read carefully the information on our section LEGALIZATION)
- 3) Copy of the passport of both parents.
- 4) Copy of the child Filipino passport.
- 5) Residence Certificate from your barangay in the Philippines as official proof of address (full details – included zip code – to be mentioned) on the name of the child.

Please note that the registration of a child born within wedlock of his parents will be done only after the registration of the marriage. Kindly read the information on our section REGISTRATION OF FACTS.

Procedure:

If you are sure that the file is complete and all conditions are fulfilled, **submit your original documents at the consular counter** (not the legalization counter) for us to proceed with the creation of the data in the national register. The documents will be kept in the child's file.

You can come to the Embassy any time during opening hours. It is not necessary to schedule an appointment. If you cannot come in person, you may send a representative with an authorization letter. The registration of a child is free of charge.
